

**ORDINANCE NO. 1-2012**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 20 ENTITLED “ENVIRONMENTAL  
COMMISSION” OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

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**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that certain amendments to Chapter 20 entitled “Environmental Commission” are necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, in all other respects Chapter 20 entitled “Environmental Commission” shall remain in full force and effect;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

**Section 1.**

Paragraph A. of §20-2. entitled “Members” shall be amended to read as follows:

A. Appointments: term. The Commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor, ~~one of whom shall also be a member of the Planning Board~~ and all of whom shall be residents of the Township. The members shall serve without compensation except as hereinafter provided. The Mayor shall designate one of the members to serve as Chairman and presiding officer of the Commission. The term of office of the Commissioners shall be for terms of three years which shall be staggered such that the terms of approximately 1/3 of the members will expire each year. The term of office of the Commissioners shall be until the appointment and qualification of their successors.

**Section 2.**

**Repealer.**

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**Section 3.**

**Severability.**

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.**

**When effective.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
