

**ORDINANCE NO. 34-2012**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,  
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 214  
ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

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**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that certain amendments and additions to Chapter 214 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" are necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, in all other respects Chapter 214 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" shall remain in full force and effect; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Committee have received complaints by residents living on or surrounding Union Road regarding excessive speeding of vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer has provided an opinion that speed reduction to 25 MPH is warranted; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the residents of Harrison Township to reduce the speed limit on Union Road to 25 MPH.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

**Section 1.**

§214-33. entitled "Speed Limits Established" shall be amended as follows:

| <b>Name of Street</b> | <b>MPH</b>              | <b>Limits</b>   |
|-----------------------|-------------------------|---|
| Union Road            | <del>35</del> <u>25</u> | Between Swedesboro Road (U.S. 322) and East Greenwich Township corporate line |

**Section 2.**

Regulatory and warning signs, conforming to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limit.

**Section 3.**

**Severability.**

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.**

**Repealer.**

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**Section 5.**

**When effective.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
