

ORDINANCE NO. 43-2012

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 97
ENTITLED "CONSTRUCTION CODES, UNIFORM" OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that certain amendments to Chapter 97 entitled "Construction Codes, Uniform" are necessary; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects Chapter 97 entitled "Construction Codes, Uniform" shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1.

§97-2. entitled "Fees" shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 97-2. Fees.

Paragraph B. of §97-2. shall be amended to read as follows:

- B. The plumbing subcode inspection fees shall be as follows and shall be paid before inspection is made. For each plumbing application, a minimum fee shall be ~~\$35~~ \$60.00. Additional fees shall apply to the following devices:

Paragraph C. of §97-2. shall be amended to read as follows:

- C. Fire protection subcode. The minimum fee for a permit shall be ~~\$40~~ \$60.00. Permit fees for fire protection devices shall be as follows:

Paragraph D. of §97-2. shall be amended to read as follows:

- D. The electrical subcode inspection fee shall be as follows and shall be paid before inspection is made. For each electrical application, a minimum fee shall be ~~\$35~~ \$60.00.

Section 2.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
