

ORDINANCE NO. 08-2013

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3-2013 TO PROVIDE FOR
THE POSITION OF DEPUTY TAX COLLECTOR AND FURTHER AMENDING THE
SALARY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2013, Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison adopted Ordinance 3-2013, entitled "An Ordinance to Fix and Determine the Ranges of the Salaries, Wages or Compensation To Be Paid To The Officers And Employees Of The Township Of Harrison, In The County Of Gloucester For The Year 2013" effective January 1, 2013 (hereafter "Salary Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Salary Ordinance confirms the titles of officers and employees of the Township and establishes their respective salary compensation range, and the Ordinance remains in effect until amended or superseded; and

WHEREAS, Township Committee seeks to amend the Salary Ordinance effective March 4, 2013 to create the new position of Deputy Tax Collector and to establish therefor the annual salary range of \$20,000.00 to \$50,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1.

1. The aforesaid Salary Ordinance is hereby amended and supplemented effective March 4, 2013 as follows:

A. The table of salaried positions is amended to add the position of "Deputy Tax Collector" and the related maximum annual salary range of \$20,000.00 to \$50,000.00

2. All other provisions of the aforesaid Salary Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
