

ORDINANCE NO. 24-2013

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 73
ENTITLED "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that certain amendments to Chapter 73 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages" are necessary; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects Chapter 73 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages" shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1.

Amending §73-3.1(2) entitled "Event Approval Exception" to include a \$25.00 Event Application Fee

§ 73-3. Event Approval Exception.

Event Approval Exception. Notwithstanding the prohibition set forth in §73-1. and §73-2., the service, possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages (wine and beer only) may be permitted only in specifically approved designated public areas and upon the conditions described below:

- I. Conditions upon which Service, Possession and/or Consumption of Beer and/or Wine may be Permitted:
 1. Only a non-profit (IRS Code 501(c)-(d)) service organization principally located within the Township of Harrison is eligible.
 2. Event permit approval by Harrison Township Committee after **payment of a non-refundable \$25.00 Event Application Fee** and the following documents and information are submitted to the Township Clerk for review with the Event Application:

Section 2.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
