

**ORDINANCE NO. 33-2013**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,  
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 43  
ENTITLED "OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP  
OF HARRISON**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that certain amendments to Chapter 43 entitled "Officers and Employees" are necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, in all other respects Chapter 43 entitled "Officers and Employees" shall remain in full force and effect;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

**Section 1.**

A new Article VII entitled "Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs" shall be added to read as follows:

**ARTICLE VII  
Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs**

**§43-39. Position created.**

The position of Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs for the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester, is hereby created and employment of a qualified person for that position is hereby authorized.

**§43-40. Qualifications.**

Requires BS/BA in Business Administration, Public Administration, economics, Marketing, or any related field; or equivalent combination of training and experiences which provides the required skills, knowledge and abilities.

**§43-41. Duties.**

The Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs shall perform such services and have such duties as shall be directed and determined by the Township Committee including, but not limited to, planning, directing and implementing comprehensive economic development programs to sustain existing business initiatives and actively seek to establish new initiatives to solicit and bring in new business enterprises within our community. Establishing a leadership role to bring all categories of merchants, EDC (local & County), Planning Board together to maximize all advantages for positive results.

**§43-41. Appointment.**

The Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs shall be appointed by the majority of the Township Committee.

**§43-42. Term of office; removal.**

The term of office of the Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs shall be at the pleasure of the Township Committee, and he/she may be removed at any time by a majority vote of the Township Committee.

**§43-43. Compensation.**

The compensation of the Director of Economic Development and Community Affairs shall be as set forth in the Harrison Township Salary Ordinance and amendments thereto.

**Section 2.**

**Repealer.**

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**Section 3.**

**Severability.**

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.**

**When effective.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
