

**ORDINANCE NO. 27-2014**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,  
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY REPEALING CHAPTER 100 ENTITLED  
"CURFEW" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 100 of the Code of the Township of Harrison entitled "Curfew" was adopted in 1973; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of Chapter 100, related State statutes and case law has preempted and/or prohibited municipal regulation of the subject matter of said Chapter; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison have determined to repeal Chapter 100 entitled "Curfew" in its entirety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

**Section 1.**

Chapter 100 of the Township of Harrison entitled "Curfew" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Section 2.**

**Repealer.**

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**Section 3.**

**Severability.**

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.**

**When effective.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
