

ORDINANCE NO. 30-2014

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING
CHAPTER 225 ENTITLED "ZONING" OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee, Township of Harrison, have determined that additional amendments to Chapter 225 entitled "Zoning", Article XIII entitled "Signs" are necessary; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects Chapter 225 entitled "Zoning" shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1.

§225-89 entitled "**General regulations.**" shall be amended to read as follows:

§225-89B(14). Temporary business signs.

(c)[5] No sign regulated by this Subsection B(14) may exceed in size ~~20~~ twenty-four (24) square feet in area.

[10] A "Best of Gloucester County" banner may be permitted if awarded to the owner of the business by the Gloucester County Board of Freeholders. Such temporary banner may not be displayed for a period more than eight (8) months following the date of the award, and shall comply with the other requirements in this Subsection B(14).

[11] Every temporary business sign shall be removed within 24 hours of the date specified in the approval.

Section 2.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 3.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
