

ORDINANCE NO. 15-2016

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY; CANCELING
CERTAIN UNFUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES
HERETOFORE PROVIDED FOR IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$15,016.31 AND REAPPROPRIATING SUCH UNFUNDED
APPROPRIATION BALANCES FOR OTHER CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Harrison, County of Gloucester, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

Section 1. The following appropriation remaining as a balance in Bond Ordinance 10-2013, heretofore adopted by the Township of Harrison, County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("Township"), is hereby cancelled:

Section 2. The sum of \$15,016.31 is hereby reappropriated from the bond ordinance referred to in Section 1 hereof for Improvements and Acquisition of Capital Equipment for the Sewer Utility in and for the Township, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor or related thereto.

Section 3. The Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Clerk and available for inspection.

Section 4. The improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are general improvements that the Township may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

Section 5. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.
