ORDINANCE 20-2016

**ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE 26-2013 OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF
GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY**

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the Township of Harrison, County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("Township") has heretofore duly and finally adopted Bond Ordinance 26-2013 authorizing the acquisition of various pieces of equipment and the completion of various capital improvements in and for the Township ("Bond Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of amending Section 7 of the Bond Ordinance to decrease the appropriation set forth in Section 7(E) and to increase the appropriation set forth in Section 7(G).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF ALL THE MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL BOND LAW, CHAPTER 169 OF THE LAWS OF 1960 OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED ("LOCAL BOND LAW"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7 of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Section 2. Section 8 of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"Section 8. The average period of useful life of the several purposes for the financing of which this Bond Ordinance authorizes the issuance of bonds or bond anticipation notes, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized for said several purposes, is not less than 12.88 years. "

Section 3. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the regulations promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail the amended capital budget and capital improvement program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, are on file with the Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 4. All other parts of the Bond Ordinance not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage
