

ORDINANCE NO. 32-2016

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING GRANT OF
TENURE FOR DENNIS M. CHAMBERS, MUNICIPAL SUPERINTENDENT OF
PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:9-154.6 authorizes the grant of tenure by the governing body of a municipality to a person holding office, position or employment as a full-time municipal superintendent of public works who has held the office, position or employment continuously for five (5) years or more; and

WHEREAS, Dennis M. Chambers has been employed by the Township of Harrison Department of Public Works since September 12, 1994; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2010, via Resolution No. 143-2010, Dennis M. Chambers was appointed as Municipal Superintendent of Public Works for the Township of Harrison; and

WHEREAS, Dennis M. Chambers has served in such supervisory capacity since the appointment effective August 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Dennis M. Chambers was awarded Certification as a Certified Public Works Manager, number M-1096, by the State of New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services on April 27, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Harrison have determined that Dennis M. Chambers is qualified to receive tenure as Municipal Superintendent of Public Works pursuant to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:9-154.6.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1

1. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:9-154.6, Dennis M. Chambers, Municipal Superintendent of Public Works for the Township of Harrison is hereby authorized as having acquired tenure in said position effective immediately.

2. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded by the Township Clerk to Dennis M. Chambers.

Section 2.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 4.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
