

RESOLUTION NO. 125-2013

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION PURSUANT TO *N.J.S.A. 10:4-13* OF THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT. MATTER(S) OF DISCUSSION PERTAIN TO LITIGATION: STATUS OF HARRISON TWP. V. ROBERT JAMES PACILLI HOMES MATTER.

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A. 10:4-12* permits the exclusion of the public from meetings of a public body in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee is of the opinion that such circumstances exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester, and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the Township Committee shall go into Executive Session at which the public shall be excluded.

2. The general nature of the subject(s) to be discussed in Executive Session:
LITIGATION: DISCUSS STATUS OF HARRISON TWP. V. ROBERT JAMES PACILLI HOMES MATTER.

3. It is anticipated at this time that the time when matters discussed in Executive Session by the Township Committee can be disclosed to the public are as follows:

A. With respect to matter involving litigation, after the litigation has been resolved by settlement or judgement and all periods of appeal have expired.

B. With respect to other matters, within 180 days from the date hereof unless disclosure at that time would be adverse to the public interest.
