**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON
AUTHORIZING TO ESTABLISH A PRELIMINARY COST APPROPRIATION FUNDED BY
THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT ACCOUNT OF THE GENERAL CAPITAL FUND**

WHEREAS, the Township of Harrison hereby acknowledges the requirement of preliminary costs to determine the scope and cost of a proposed undertaking. The purpose of these preliminary costs are for the services of a licensed architect relating to the proposed construction of a police station and that the amount to be charged is for the purpose for which bonds may be issued under Chapter 2 of Title 40A,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the amount appropriated for preliminary costs shall not exceed \$35,000 and the Treasurer is authorized to set up a reserve for preliminary expenses out of the Capital Improvement Fund of the General Capital Fund.
