A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE NEW JERSEY RECOVERY CAMPAIGN

Whereas, Superstorm Sandy and many other intense storm systems have left our community with many dead and damaged trees; and

Whereas, the New Jersey Recovery Campaign is an organization which offers assistance to communities through the distribution of seedlings to replace dead or dying trees; and

Whereas, Harrison Township wishes to participate in the New Jersey Tree Recovery Campaign through acceptance of seedlings; and

Whereas, Harrison Township officials will organize a tree distribution event to offer packets of five (5) seedlings to all interested residents;

Now, therefore be it resolved that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Harrison hereby authorize participation in the New Jersey Tree Recovery Campaign.

Be it further resolved that the Mayor and Township Committee authorize the township to receive and distribute tree seedlings.
