**RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON,
IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY
CONCERNING DEFERRAL OF SCHOOL TAX LEVY**

WHEREAS, by Statute, when a municipality raises school taxes on a school year basis, an amount of not more than fifty percent (50%) of the levy may be deferred to the following year; and

WHEREAS, fifty percent (50%) of the 2014/15 school tax levy of the Clearview Regional High School District is \$4,657,096.50; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Harrison, desires to defer school taxes for the year ended December 31, 2015, in the amount of \$4,257,399.86.
