

RESOLUTION NO. 09-2016

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON
AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND SERVICES OF AN
EXTRAORDINARY UNSPECIFIABLE NATURE TO AN ATTORNEY SPECIALIZING IN
MATTERS RELATING TO SEWER TREATMENT PLANT FACILITIES, KEVIN VANHISE,
FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HARRISON, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER AND STATE OF NEW
JERSEY**

WHEREAS, there exists a need for the services of legal counsel who has special expertise in sewer treatment plant facilities to be performed for the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester; and

WHEREAS, funds will be made available for this purpose in the 2016 Budget and in the meantime have been made available by temporary appropriation resolution as provided for by *N.J.S.* 40A:4-19; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (*N.J.S.* 40A:11-1 et seq.) in effect provides that Contracts for Professional Services and Contracts for Services of an Extraordinary Unspecifiable Nature may be negotiated by the governing body of a municipality without public advertising and bidding, but requires a brief notice of the fact and details of each such contract to be publicly advertised and that the contract and authorizing resolution be filed in the Municipal Clerk's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Harrison, in the County of Gloucester as follows:

That **KEVIN A. VAN HISE, ESQ** an Attorney-at-Law (Mason, Griffin & Pierson) of the State of New Jersey (a person authorized by law to practice a recognized profession), having offices at 101 Poor Farm Road, Princeton, New Jersey 08540, be and he hereby is appointed as special counsel for the Township for the year 2016, to perform such duties and services as may be required of a special counsel; and the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with said **KEVIN A. VAN HISE, ESQ** for services concerning sewer treatment plant facilities for such consideration and charges as are just and proper in accordance with fees established by the profession as set forth in the copy of the contract attached hereto; This contract is being awarded on a month-to-month basis and therefore may be terminated by either party with thirty days notice of intent to terminate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this contract is awarded without competitive bidding as exceptions in the Local Public Contracts Law, either because said party contracted with is authorized by law to practice a recognized profession in the State of New Jersey or the services to be performed are extraordinary unspecifiable services which cannot be bid competitively because it is impossible to prepare specifications for same in accordance with the above mentioned statutes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of said notice as required by *N.J.S. 40A:11-5* shall be published in the Township's primary newspaper within ten days after passage of this Resolution.
