

Dear Mr. Horne:

The Department is in receipt of a submission dated April 14, 2014 regarding the acceptance of paper residuals from Marcal Manufacturing, LLC, in Elmwood Park, New Jersey at the Henry Harris Landfill.

Paper residuals do not fit into any of the approved specific categories within the July 2006 Material Acceptance Plan (MAP). However, the Department has determined that, based on the physical characteristics, the material is similar in nature to the approved categories and as such, the acceptance of paper residuals will not require Site Plan Approval from the municipality pursuant to the Legacy Landfill Law.

After reviewing the submission, and after internal discussions, the Department hereby approves the acceptance of 2,500 cubic yards of paper residual from Marcal with the following conditions:


1. The dioxin level cannot exceed 700 parts per trillion (.7 parts per billion);
2. Additional quantities of the material received at the landfill shall be sampled at the following frequency:
 - One (1) 5-point composite sample for TCL+30 / TAL Metals, cyanide, PCBs and hexavalent chromium for every 2,500 cubic yards of material;

- One (1) 5-point composite sample for dioxins/furans by 1613B for every 5,000 cubic yards of material (approximately 2 per quarter);

3. The material shall be blended at a minimum ratio of 3 parts soil to 1 part paper residual.
